Northwest Narwhals Swim at Brantford and Kenora

Congratulations to Alyssa Bossio, Emma Covello, Ilana Mironsky, Lawson Mironsky, Morgan LaBelle and Brittney Felix who attended the 39th Annual Swim International in Brantford Ontario November 7, 8 and 9th. Here the team competed against over 1200 swimmers holding their own. Alyssa placed 12th in the 100 Back, 19th in the 200 Breast, 23rd in the 200 Free, 24th in the 50 Free, 26th in the 200 IM and 40th in the 100 Free. Emma ranked 8th in the 50 Free, 12th in the 100 Breast, 15th in the 200 Breast, 13th in the 100 Free along with two 20th place finishes in the 200 Free and IM. Brittney finished 27th in the 200 Breast, 34th in the 100 Breast, 44th in the 100 Fly, 51st in the 200 IM, 52th in the 200 Free and 63rd in the 50 and 100 Free. Morgan had a 39th in the 400 IM, 46th in the 200 Back, 53rd in the 400 Free, 58th in the 200 IM, 67th in the 200 Free, 73rd in the 100 Free and 76th in the 50 Free. Ilana had 9th in the 200 Back, 13th in the 200 Free and Breast and 21 in the 100 Breast.

Lawson swam his first meet in water wings and the good news it kept him off the bottom of the pool and saved Mr. Happy from peril.

On November 15 and 16 a contingent of 9 attended the Kenora Swimming Sharks Fall Invitational along with Head Coach, David Iwaynszyn with outstanding results. Ana Barcena (8) swam in the competition for the first time coming in second in the 50 Back and 100 Free along with a 4th in the 50 Free. Rowan Sharp finished 2nd in the 50 Breast, 4th in the 200 Free, 5th in the 100 Free and Breast, 6th in the 50 Free, 7th in the 50 Back, 8th in the 50 Fly and 9th in the 100 Back. Emma Cournoyer (10) finished with a pair of 4th place finishes in the 50 Back and 50 Breast; a 5th in the 200 IM; 7th in the 100 Free; 8th in the 200 Free; 11th in the 50 Free and 12th in the 100 Breast. Mackenzie McCuaig (10) also had a pair of 4th place finishes in the 100 Breast and 200 IM; 6th in the 50 Fly; 8th in the 100 Free and 50 Free and 10th in the 100 Back and 50 Back. Rounding out the girls was Heather Eyben who achieved 1st in the 50 Breast, 3rd in the 50 Free and 100 IM, 5th in the 50 Back and 100 Breast, 6h in the 50 Fly and 200 Free.

In the boys division David Iwaynszyn Jr. (9) swam to a 10th place finish in the 50 Back, 12th in the 100 free and 13th in the 50 Free. Diego Barcena-Martinez (10) won 1st in the 100 Back; a 2nd in the 50 Fly, 50 Back, 100 Free and 400 Free; 4th in the 200 Free and 6th in the 50 Free. Eric Osala (14) swam to 3 2nd place finishes in the 50 Fly, 50 Breast and 100 Fly; 4th in the 100 Breast, 5th in the 50 Back, a pair of 6th place finishes in the 50 Free and 100 Free along with a 8th place finish in the 100 Back. Cameron Mackey (15) won the 50 Back, placed 2nd in the 50 Breast; 3rd in the 50 Free, 100 Fly, 200 Free and 400 Free; 4th in the 100 Free and 100 Breast.

Next up the Narwhals host the 2014 Allstate Northwest Narwhal Invitational on November 29 and 30th at the Lakehead University Pool.
