Northwest Narwhals at KSS Fall Invitational, Kenora ON

Fifteen swimmers attended the KSS Fall Invite on November 7 and 8, 2015 with Head Coach David Iwanyszyn at the helm.

Brooke and Charlotte Ailey swam in competition for the first time with outstanding results. Charlotte (8) had a First in the 50 Breast and 50 Fly along with 3 other top 8 finishes in the 8 and under girls division. Brooke (11) held her own in the tough 11-12 girls division with top 20 finishes in all her swims.

Malcom Bath (10) competing in the 9-10 boys group swam to a 1st in the 100 Free, 50 Free along with 2nd in the 50 Back, 100 IM, 100 Free and 100 Back. Malcom slashed nearly 50 seconds off his 200 Free.

Zoe Bath (12) achieved 75% personal best times cutting a massive 28 and 21 seconds off her 200 Free and 100 Breast. All her results put her in the top 20 of the division including an 8th in the 50 Back.

Alyssa Bossio (13) swimming in the 13-14 girls never left the top 3 in results with 3 1st place finishes in the 50 Back, 200 Breast and 1500 Free; 4 2nd place finishes in the 100 Fly, 100 Breast, 200 IM, and 100 Free and a 3rd in the 50 Free.

Carson Cambly (9) swam strong in the boys 9-10 class with a 2nd in the 50 Breast, 3rd in the 100 Back and 4 4th place finishes in the balance of his swims.

Mathew Dafoe (15) in the 15 and over male division swam his first 1500 Free to finish 1st and also never left the top 3 in results. He rounded out the weekend with 2nd in 100 Fly, 50 Back, 100 IM, 200 Breast and 50 Fly along with a pair of 3rd's in the 50 and 100 Free.

Liam Francis (12) swimming in the boys 11-12 swam hard to stay in the top 2 for all his swims finishing number 1 in the 50 Back, 50 Free and 100 Free. He also had 2nd place in 200 Free, 100 Fly, 200 IM, 400 Free and 50 Fly.

David Iwanyszyn Jr. (10) had an outstanding weekend in the 9-10 Boys cutting an incredible 93 seconds off his 200 Free and 15 seconds in his 100 IM. David had all top 7 finishes for all his swims ranking 4th in the 100 IM, 100 Back and 50 Fly.

Andrew Leschuk (13) held his own in the 13-14 Boys group with 100% top 10 results including a 2nd in the grueling 400 IM along with a pair of 3rds in the 100 Fly and 100 IM.

Ilana Mironsky (12) competing in the 11-12 Girls division had top 3 rankings for all swims. She swam to a 1st place finish in the 100 Back along with 2nd in the 100 Fly, 400 IM, 200 IM, 50 Breast and 800 Free. She had a pair of 3rd's in the 200 Free and 50 Free.

Donovan Moor (14) in the 13-14 Boys stayed in the top 5 for all his results. Highlights include a 1st in 100 IM, a pair of 2nd's in the 50 Back and 100 Breast along with a 3rd in the 100 Free.

Emma (14) and Kate (13) Moorhouse swam against each other in the 13-14 Girls division staying top 8 for all their results. Emma swam strong to finish 2nd in the 400 IM, 50 Breast, 50 Fly, and 1500 Free. She also had a 3rd in the 100 Fly. Kate held her own with a 2nd in the 100 IM cutting 23 seconds and 3rd in the 50 Breast.

Eric Osala (15) in the 15 and over Boys stayed 1 and 2 for all swims finishing 1st in the 50, 100 and 200 Fly, 50 Back, 100 IM and 100 Back. He had 2nd place finishes in the 50 and 100 Free.

Next up the team competes at their home meet the 2015 NWN Allstate Invitational on November 28 and 29th at LU Pool.
